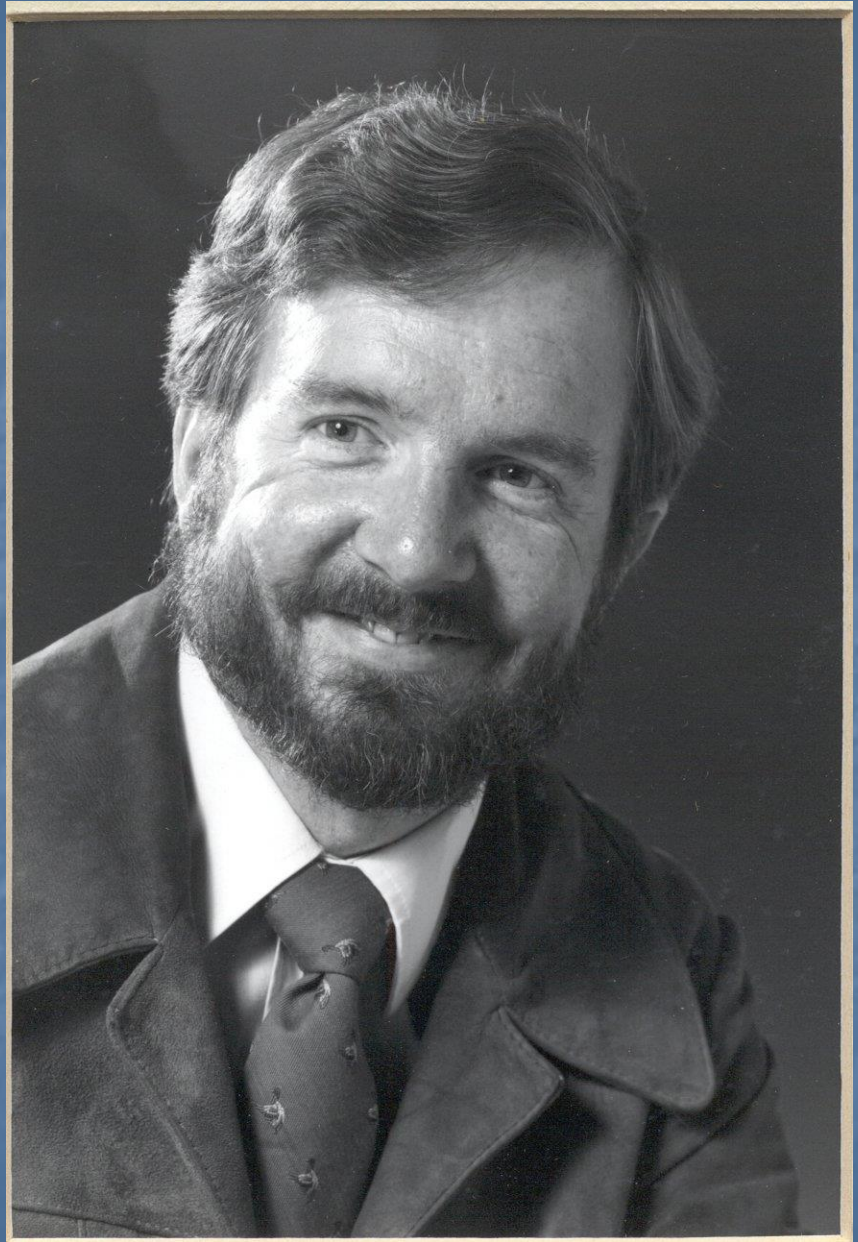

Chad Timeline

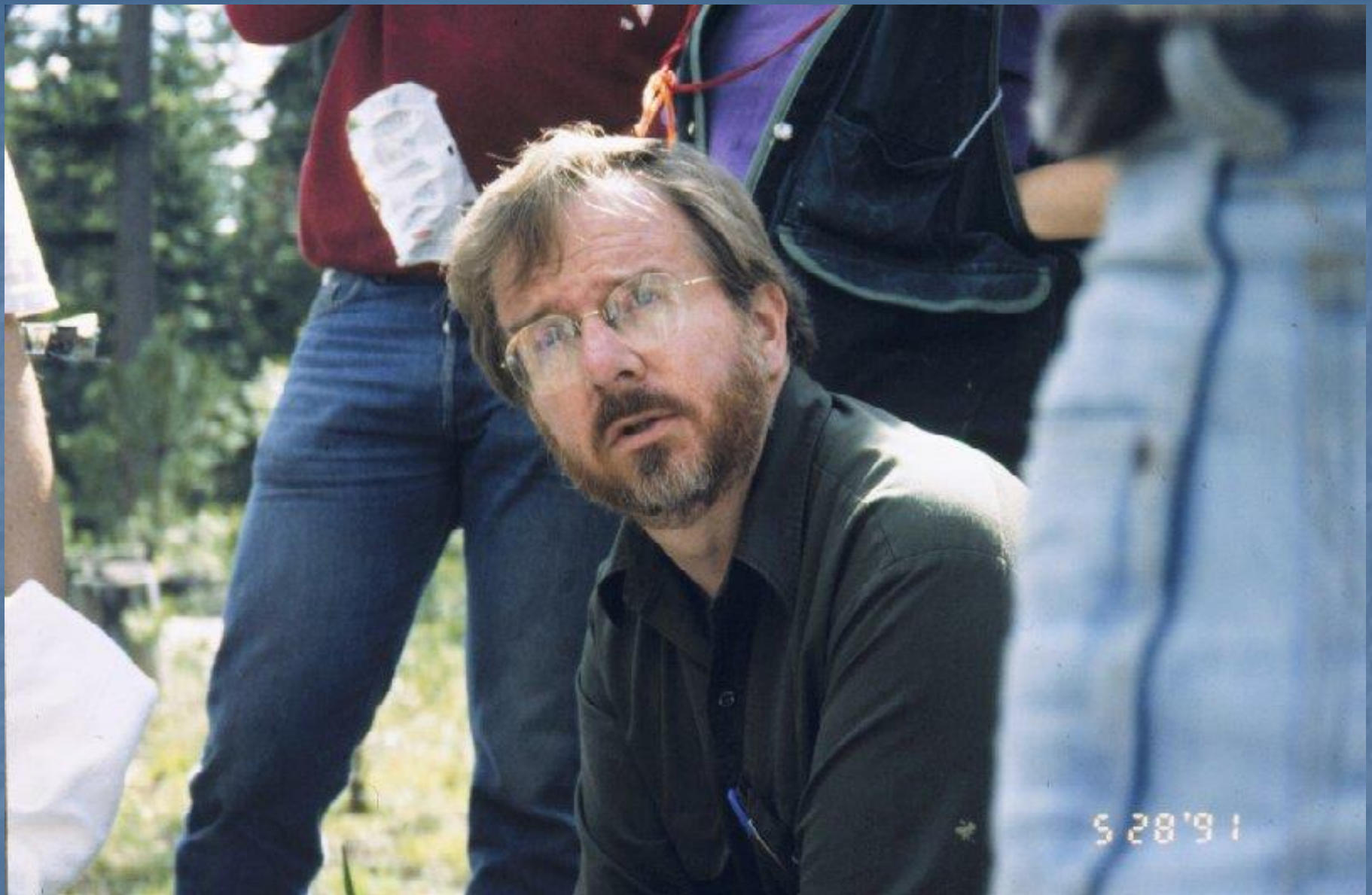
- Born 1947 – Camden, South Carolina

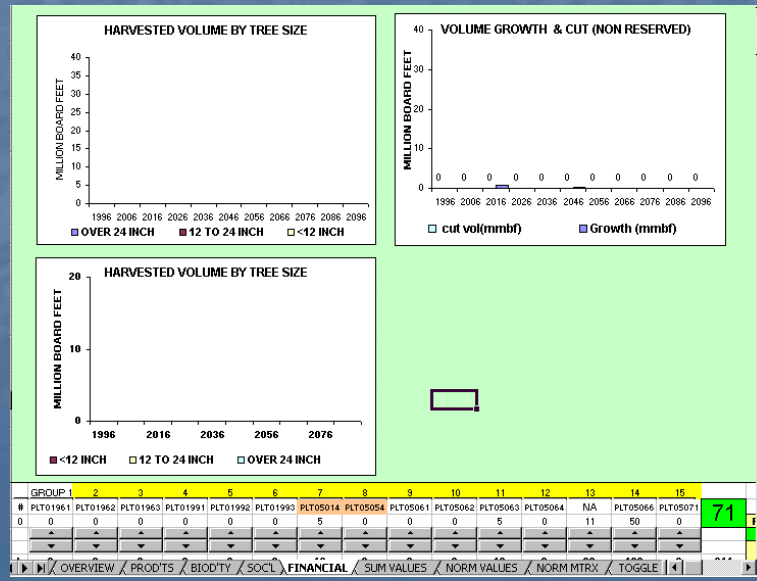
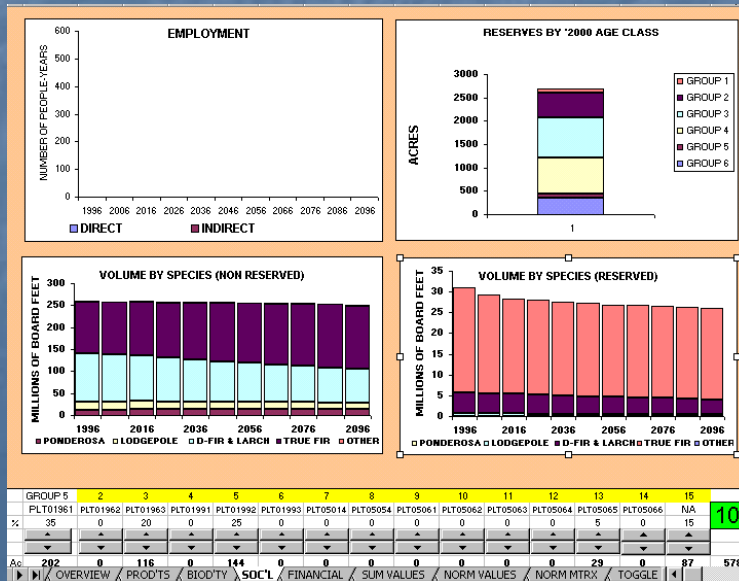
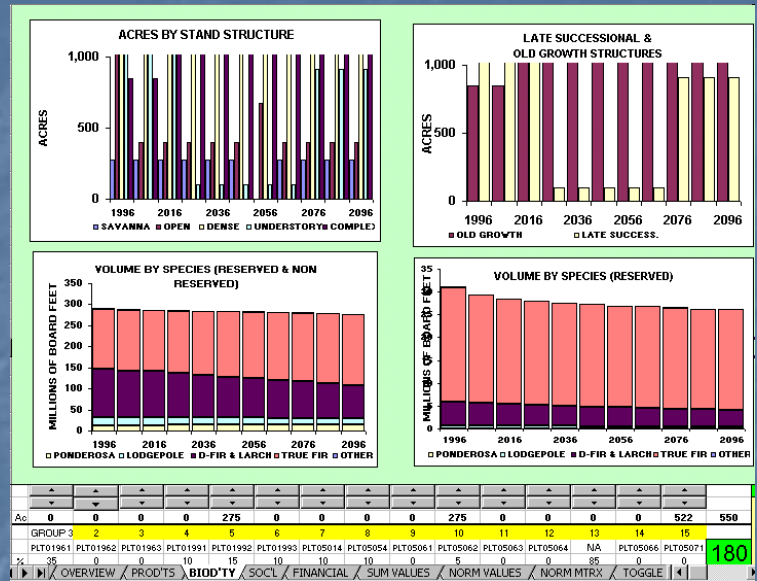
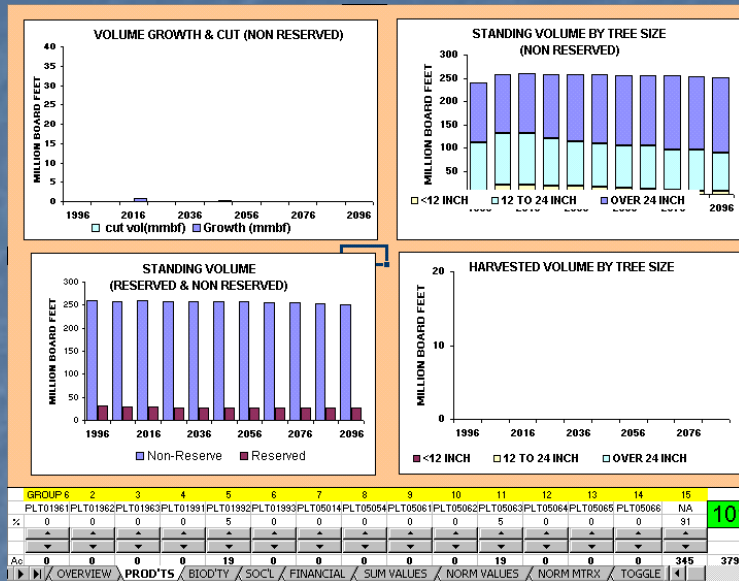
After a several desktop computers Chad decided that a notebook computer would be more fun to lug around
